

DAY 1: GROUP PICK-UP, HOTEL CHECK-IN, LOIRE RIVER FLOAT & WELCOME COCKTAIL WITH AURELIEN, PRIVATELY HOSTED GOURMET PICNIC - D

Meet at Saint Pierre des Corps rail station at 2:00 PM. Check-in at our 4-star Hotel – Le Pavillon des Lys in historic Amboise for the 6 day/5 night – Loire Valley France Tour Itinerary – (NO HOTEL HOPPING – We Stay in 1 Boutique Hotel Owned by Local Friends for the Entire Tour). Travelers take a TGV (high speed) train from either Paris Charles de Gaulle Airport or Gare de Montparnasse in downtown Paris to reach the Saint Pierre des Corps TGV rail station.

LATE AFTERNOON: Winding our way along the Loire River, our next stop of the day is the port of Chaumont-sur-Loire where we'll meet up with local friend Aurelien along the banks of the Loire River. Aurelien welcomes us aboard his traditional wooden, flat bottom boat, called a "tout," for a float down the Loire River taking in the beautiful landscapes, wildlife and unparalleled views of the castles sprinkled along the river banks. We'll float peacefully along our route enjoying a welcome "aperitif" and orientation to the week's activities before arriving in Amboise to a magical view from our boat of the Royal Castle of Amboise at sunset.

DO I NEED TO BE AN ATHLETE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE LOIRE VALLEY TOUR?

No. However, France is a country of walkers. Our Loire Valley Tour is designed for active travelers and includes extensive leisure walking daily. Travelers need to be able to walk and stand for extended periods of time while listening to commentary/history about the castles during visits. This tour is not suitable for travelers with serious back or knee problems. It is not possible to drop-off or pick-up guests at the entry of castles before or after visits, and therefore guests must be able to walk short distances from the vans to the sites, as well as be able to also enjoy exploring historical villages, towns and corresponding markets on foot. We enjoy the "slow road" taking in the

beautiful scenery of the castles and local villages daily, and our tours are focused on actively discovering this magnificent region.

WHAT IS THE WEATHER GOING TO BE LIKE IN THE LOIRE VALLEY?

April through October, day time temperatures in the Loire Valley range from the 70's- to mid-80's Fahrenheit with evenings being slightly cooler. Typically it is sunny, but be prepared with the proper rain gear.
