

• WALK #1 -For Walkers: The GUIDED --"LES ALPILLES VILLAGE TO VILLAGE WALK"-- from Les Baux to St. Remy is rated moderate (optional: designed for interested guests). Sturdy walking shoes recommended. Walking on vineyard and country trails with occasional ascents and uneven terrain. The trail offers spectacular views of Les Baux Valley and the castle, and on a clear day, one can see all the way to the Mont Ventoux - The walk is rated moderate-Ideal for those who walk more seriously on a regular basis. Walk distance is 5 miles - approximately 2 hrs. of walking depending on photo-op stops. For non-walkers: shuttle by comfortable minivan to Les Baux de Provence village for a guided tour and leisure time to discover the village. Shopping, wine tasting, art galleries and cafés and restaurants are available in the village. <u>PLEASE NOTE</u> -- There is a longer trail option available for passionate walkers in the group - the longer trail is 11 miles total distance with some short term elevation gain, scrambling and more pronounced ascents/descents.

WALK #2 - For Walkers: The GUIDED -- "LUBERON VALLEY VILLAGE TO VILLAGE WALK"-

- from Gordes to Roussillon in the Luberon region of Provence is rated easy to moderate (optional: designed for interested guests). Walking on vineyard and country trails through picturesque lansdcapes and French country architecture, lavender and sunflower fields with a variety of beautiful villages in the background. Ideal for those who walk for a morning or afternoon on a regular basis. Walk distance is 6 miles - approximately 2-2.5 hrs. depending on photo-op stops. For non-walkers: shuttle by comfortable minivan to each village for guided tours and leisure time to discover these beautiful villages in the Luberon. Shopping, wine tasting, art galleries and cafés and restaurants are available in each village.

• WALK #3 - For Walkers: The GUIDED --- "HIDDEN GEMS OF PROVENCE WALK"--- begins in the historic village of Eygalières and is rated easy to moderate (optional: designed for interested guests). Walking on vineyard and country trails through picturesque lansdcapes and French country architecture with a variety of beautiful villages and endless olive or-chards in the background and along our walking trail. Ideal for those who walk for a morning or afternoon on a regular basis. Walk distance is 6 miles - approximately 2-2.5 hrs. depending on photo-op stops. For non-walkers: shuttle by comfortable minivan to Eygaliès for leisure time to discover this beautiful, historical village. Shopping, wine tasting, art galleries and cafés and restaurants are available in the village. <u>PLEASE NOTE</u> -- There is a longer trail option available for passionate walkers in the group - the longer trail is 12 miles total distance with no added degree of difficulty as far as terrain and ascents/descents are concerned.

DAY 1: GUESTS MEET GUIDES AT AVIGNON TGV STATION - TRANSFER TO HOTEL FOR CHECK-IN, WELCOME COCKTAIL HOUR AND DINNER - D

Meet and Greet by tour guides at AVIGNON TGV Rail Station at scheduled 4 PM group pick-up time and location inside the TGV station. Transfer, as a group, to our luxury, historical hotel in the heart of the Gallo-Roman village town of St. Remy-de-Provence.

COCKTAILS & WELCOME DINNER: Welcome cocktail hour and dinner. Dinner dress is casual. Welcome cocktail hour -- during our welcome cocktail your Provence Tour Guides will discuss the tour activities of the week and respond to any questions or requests. ST. REMY-DE-PROVENCE MARKET.

Morning perusing and shopping at the weekly market in the town that inspired some of Van Gogh's most famous art work. Noble names of our time include Princess Diana who once had a home here and Princess Caroline of Monaco. Situated in the heart of the Alpilles, surrounded by lush valleys of olive trees and Baux de Provence vineyards, the sounds of cicadas chirping, the visual delight of plane trees and flowers and its Gallo-Roman architecture, St. Remy reflects the heart and soul of Provence. Market day in town is a must for any stay in Provence.

LUNCH: Together at our favorite celebrity bistro made famous by Chef and Cookbook author Patricia Wells.

AFTERNOON: ALL GUESTS SHUTTLE TO LES BAUX DE PROVENCE VILLAGE AND FROM THERE CHOOSE ONE OF THE OPTIONS BELOW. **We stop en-route to Les Baux de Provence to visit a local olive oil mill.**

In Provence olive oil plays an important role in daily cuisine, and before our arrival to Les Baux village, we'll be welcomed as special guests to one of the most famous olive oil mills of the region owned by our local French friends for a private tour and tasting.

OPTION #1 - WALKERS : "ALPILLES VILLAGE TO VILLAGE" WALK - FROM LES BAUX DE PROVENCE TO ST. REMY DE PROVENCE.

Guided "ALPILLES VILLAGE TO VILLAGE WALK" of the southern Alpilles area of Provence. This spectacular walk begins in Les Baux de Provence village taking guests on a scenic trail from the village through the southern Alpilles most prominent olive orchards and vineyards (option to visit a local winery), and through Les Alpilles forest.

OPTION #2 - NON-WALKERS: SHUTTLE TO/FROM LES BAUX DE PROVENCE VILLAGE

by comfortable Mercedes Sprinter for a guided tour and leisure time in this beautiful village. Castle ruins, shopping, wine tasting, art galleries, cafes and restaurants are available in the village.

OPTION #1 -

WALKERS : MORNING "LUBERON VALLEY VILLAGE TO VIL-LAGE " WALK - FROM GORDES. TO ROUSSILLON.

Guided "LUBERON VILLAGE TO VILLAGE WALK" - (optional - designed for interested guests) - Participate in a Spectacular, guided walk from Gordes to Roussillon. The Luberon countryside is absolutely beautiful with incredible, often unexpected variety and offers the perfect setting for a golden walking experience unlike any other. Comprised of very unique experiences, our Luberon walk takes us from Gordes, a golden stone village with an imposing noble 11th century castle, to Roussillon, a famous artist village whose history evolved around the tale of a red-headed damsel and her troubadour lover. We'll pass through farms, vineyards, orchards and woods, past beautifully restored homes and simple farm dwellings. The area surrounding the Luberon is a designated natural park. The countryside is rich with bits of history and evidence of life from other times, and on foot you'll discover special places that aren't in the tourist guidebooks. We pass prehistoric caves, ancient bories, a Roman oppidium, old mills, 700-year old chapels, and abandoned villages. Also famous for its vineyard and lavender covered countryside, walking in the Luberon offers photo opportunities of spectacular colors of lavender, poppies and sunflowers, and scenery that will completely contrast your experience in the Alpilles and along the Mediterranean coast.





OPTION **#2** – Non–Walkers : Shuttle from village to village for guided tours of and free time to explore two of the most beautiful, hilltop villages in the picturesque "Luberon" area of Provence made famous by Peter Mayle's books *A YEAR IN PROVENCE* and *A GOOD YEAR* - Roussillon and Gordes villages. There will be stops for photo opts along the way.

LUNCH: A Gourmet French picnic together amidst the vineyards of the Lubéron Valley comprised of specialty and regional products traditional to Provence and accompanied by a selection of classified Chateauneuf-du-Pape and Hermitage (for walkers and non-walkers).

GORDES village, one of the most stunning of the hilltop villages of Provence, appears like an Atlantis surrounded by fields instead of ocean. To one side looms the massif of



Mount Ventoux, the Olympus of Provence, to the other, the pastoral whale-back of Mount Luberon. The breadth and height of this region balance in utter serenity in Gordes. The viewpoint of our initial stop perches us dizzyingly at a canyons edge across from which the village could be mistaken for a masonery version of an anthill. The village's private homes, chateau and imposing church form a kind of medieval cliff-dwelling community. Arriving to the village center, we are afforded a stroll of the cobbled lanes where dry stone walls serrate the magical vistas of the sunny land at our feet.

ROUSSILLON We'll visit, explore and shop in the artist village of Roussillon, a colorful hilltop village that reflects the canto of color and harbors tales of a mythical story of a lover, a murder and the suicide of the faithful bereft that describes how the name of the village honors a redhead. The romance, colors, the very ground and reddish walls of the buildings that line its winding streets make Roussillon a very special place in Provence. Known as the village of ochre, this unique mineral creates a substance formerly used as a dying agent. A meandering walk of the preserved ochre quarry reveals the handiwork of nature amidst the collapsing excavations of man. The residents of Roussillon are predominately artists and artisans. This has led to many shops being authentic and individual in character. Explore the village and the colorful Ochre Park.

DAY 4: FULL DAY ALONG THE MEDITERRANEAN COAST IN THE WINE PRODUCING VILLAGE OF CASSIS - B, L, D

-- Introduction to Cassis Village and Shop at the Cassis Weekly Market, Gourmet Michelin-star Lunch Together with Classified Cassis Wines, 45 minute Afternoon Cruise on the Mediterranean Sea to View the historical Calanques (Fjords), Leisure Time, Dinner Together

BUFFET BREAKFAST.

CASSIS – Departure for a full day in the picturesque Mediterranean coastal, wine producing village of Cassis, France which dates back to 500 BC, is surrounded by vineyards, and bordered by the Mediterranean sea, colorful cliffs and beach. Stroll through this art deco style village's pedestrian streets for photo ops of the cobblestone streets, colorful port and beautiful vineyard covered coastline. Shop and try a local cafe at the port. It's market day also in Cassis and the coastal markets offer a completely different experience to that of inland Provence. Peruse the stands, taste artisan products, and photograph the colorful stands and products on offer.



LUNCH: A Gourmet Michelin-Star lunch together overlooking the Mediterranean Sea, prepared by one of our favorite Michelin-star chefs and accompanied by classified Cassis wines.

A DAY ALONG THE MEDITERRANEAN COAST IN CASSIS -

CALANQUES VIEWING CRUISE & OTHER OPTIONS – On arrival in Cassis guests enjoy an introduction to the village, then have the opportunity to shop at the morning market and village shops. At noon enjoy a fabulous Mediterranean lunch at the port overlooking the sea. After lunch embark on a scenic 45 minute boat tour of the historical, Mediterranean calanques. Afterwards, enjoy a home-made ice-cream. Discover typical Mediterranean decor and quaint cafés while exploring the historic streets -- take time to enjoy a glass of locally produced Cassis wine and people watch while seated at a café or brasserie along the colorful port. Some guests may also wish to go for a swim in the Mediterranean Sea or sunbath at the beautiful beach -- changing facilities are available at the beach -- your guides will direct you where to go.


